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<p>4 NEW BUSINESS</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> CarFit – Ms. Curran provided information about CarFit which is a similar concept to the child car seat inspections, for older adults. Car safety trained technicians check the cars of older adults for driver fit and safety, with the goal of preventing MVCs among the elderly. Baylor Scott & White Hospital has grant funding for the program and seeking partnership for a location for the classroom training. (It will be followed by the actual CarFit event for seniors which will be held somewhere else in the community.) Ms. Sarah Schwaller has asked if the training class could be held at the SETRAC office on March 16, 2017 and would like to invite all the Injury Prevention Coordinators to attend. Committee members suggested to possible create a small Injury Prevention newsletter to include injury prevention events as well as monthly awareness dates and programs.
