<p>Subgroup Reports</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Data/QI Update <p>a) <u>SETRAC Data Review</u></p> <p>The Quarter 4 2017 data was reviewed by the committee. The number of hospitals not reporting has dropped from 100% to 94%, which may have cause the slight drop in number of STEMI patients reported in the region.</p> <p>Data continues to show that of the patients transferred to another facility for PCI, about half arrive within the 120-minute guidelines for first door to balloon. For this quarter 10 out of 71 patients transferred had a door-in door-out (DIDO) time of less than 30 minutes at the first hospital and only 3 patients received lytics.</p> <p>Mr. Caliva charged the committee to come-up with a non-PCI CEO report to show how those facilities are handling STEMI patients. For 2018, the report would be blinded, with the goal of unblinding the data in 2019. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Protocol / Education Update <p>Dr. Rohith Malya, Sharla Shumaker, Connie Bryant, and Allen Sims met with Genentech to discuss a plan to cover lytics education at the non-PCI facilities and ensure the facilities are stocking lytics by the end of the year. Education would be set up by regions and include presentations by physicians about why lytics administration is important and Genentech about supply and exchange program for TNK. This will apply to the freestanding EDs as well.</p> <p>The subcommittee will look at the PCI facilities that have high fallouts for transfer patients.</p> <p>The committee discussed and recommended that PCI facilities that need to transfer a patient to another facility for PCI should administer lytics, even if it is believed the door-to-balloon time will be met.</p> 	<p>The non-PCI tool kit that is on the SETRAC website needs to be reviewed and revised if necessary.</p> <p>In the future, a working group will be formed to look at providing a certificate to the non-PCI facilities that are administrating lytics and ensure that the facilities continue to adhere to the standards.</p>	<p>Standing report.</p>
