The group will begin to look at options to obtain the data.</li> <li>• <b>Gun Safety</b> – Ms. Garza provided an update on the Mayors Taskforce – Commission on Gun Violence. A suggestion was made to have this committee look at ways to partner and spread education on Gun Safety.
