A. Call to Order

Holly Mitchell called the meeting to order at 1:05 pm.

B. <u>Minutes</u> (C101)

• EMTrack Overview (C104)

Fidel Calvillo reviewed the year end survey which outlined the corridor members would like more EMTrack, WebEOC, CMOC, decon training. One of the top focuses was EMTrack training.

D. <u>HPP Capabilities Review</u> (C101)

- End OF Year Survey Out of the 139 hospitals, only 73 completed the end of year survey. SETRAC will be reaching out to those who did not complete survey.
- CMOC Plan Review SETRAC is working with UASI to update the Regional CMOC plan. The plan is in the final revision stage.

E. EMTF Update (C306)

Mark Sastre distributed and reviewed the upcoming EMTF events and trainings (*document filed with minutes*). He highlighted a few events as follows:

• The Southeast Texas Regional Planning Commission was one of the five jurisdictions in the state to receive the Complex Coordinated Terrorist Attack grant. This is a two-year

program that will culminate into a full-scale exercise in May 2020 which will involve pre-hospital and hospital participation.

- A survey is currently available at "survey.setrac.org" to assist in assessing current regional EMS wildland fire capabilities.
- The Houston Marathon is scheduled for this weekend. An incident "Houston Marathon" has been created in WebEOC for this event.
- South Padre Spring Break will be held on March 14th-17th and the Type 1 MMU is being deployed to operate 24/7 with doctors, nurses, paramedics, and support staff. Anyone interested in participating in this event can contact Mr. Sastre at <u>mark.sastre@setrac.org</u>.
- 100 TDEM iPhones have been assigned to the EMTF6 region for deployment upon state mission activations. The phones are equipped with the asset track, ETN, and Motorola WAVE app.

The LTC quarterly meeting is scheduled for February 13th at the SETRAC office.
