<p>2 PEDIATRIC TRAUMA REGISTRY UPDATES – SETRAC</p> <p>2017 Qtrs. 1-3 Pediatric Data – The group reviewed the requested detailed data reports (death detail by MOI, Age and ISS and trended data 2014-2017). The group asked to have the Top 5 MOI's and deaths on separate reports and would like to know why non-accidental trauma is not showing up on the reports. The group also asked to look at zip code data for burn injuries on a separate report.</p> <p>There was a discussion about Gun Safety education. Dr. Cox suggested that the group partner with UT or another research group and review Pediatric trauma data to drive injury prevention strategies and education in the region.</p> <p>A suggestion was made for the group to decide on a few data elements they would like to focus on and only review those specific reports at the meetings. Currently there are 30 separate pediatric data reports generated each quarter.
