Noted Darrell started with Trauma program managers for a better result. 5 responses received. Letters sent twice; 1 week apart. Letters did not go to Pediatric hospitals. Requested additional participation. Next steps: start targeted outreach and education once PECC leader list is compiled. This will go out to EMS agencies. 4/5 do not have PECC leader. HCA Gulf Coast noted having PECC leaders. This will also go out to EMS agencies.</p>	<p>Send letter to EMS agencies</p>
<p>Presenter: Garrett Hall</p> <p>Topic: 2019 Goals</p>	<p>Noted establishing 2 workgroups. The education workgroup goal is being met. The pediatric practice guideline workgroup has not formally met but have established a topic via email of Image Dosage for Pediatric patients. Literature reviews are in progress. Email with webinar will be sent out for next workgroup meeting prior to the committee meeting on August 8th. ACS has released an imaging guideline specific to pediatrics and each body area. Tammi Culp to join this group. Open to EMS and hospitals. Will draft a general overview for first guideline in upcoming months. From a regional standpoint, we can recommend EMS adopt the evidence-based guidelines and recommend hospitals contract with agencies that utilizes best practice guidelines. Dr. Kidd noted the previously discussed pedi and firearm safety collaborative.
