<p>Presenter: Allison Capetillo</p> <p>Topic: Houston Grant: Improving Treatment Rates in Eligible Patients</p>	<p>Allison noted the AHA has received support from Genentech to combat the RI TM issue. Funds have been granted. Houston selected as pilot market among Boston and Philadelphia. This is a subproject under Target Stroke. Noted having free range to cater to Houston needs. Definition of disabling reviewed. Any remaining deficit the patient or practitioner considers potentially disabling. Questions to identify disabling reviewed.</p> <p>Target stroke performance 2010-2018 reviewed and showed great improvement.</p> <p>Tools reviewed. Easy button report will launch in the Fall for patients that arrive in the window with no contraindications. Requested members fill out feedback questionnaire. Noted members can place ED representative on feedback form. Upcoming events reviewed. <p>Presenter: Donald Garrett</p> <p>Topics: Quarter 1 Data Review</p>	<p>All data reviewed. Stroke volumes have increased. Pending one hospital's data. Noted monitoring the 4% as the prehospital stroke algorithm is rolled out. This will be captured on the jot form. Inquired if there has there been any discussion about perfusion for the 67% >3.5hr. Members noted the lack of rapid read and proper CT machine.</p> <p>Consents are obtained prior to advanced imaging. Dr. Savitz agreed to share consents with the committee. Inquired if primaries will ever obtain the equipment for advanced imaging.</p> <p>Noted increase in RI/TM. Dr. Savitz noted prior anticoagulant is also a question being discussed nationally.</p> <p>Aaron from MH Katy inquired about adding a field that states, "patient returned to baseline". SETRAC database is adding this option. In the meantime, these patients are being put in the "other" category.</p>	<p>Dr. Savitz to share consents with committee</p>



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	<p>RI/TM blinded data by hospital reviewed. Percentages will be broken down by patients that arrived in the 4.5 hr window. Will take to data committee and discuss if this can be placed in the CEO report or just used as a quality improvement tool. Recommended baseline number for hospital interventions. Recommended adding the NIHSS score.</p>	
<p>Presenter: Donald Garrett Topic: Stroke Data Subcommittee</p>	<p>LVO data form was sent to comprehensive facilities. Will get with AHA for report to pull data. New format may be coming out soon. Will coordinate efforts with those that do not use GWTG. Reiterated RI/TM definition will be changing soon. RI category will move to the "other" category which will be unacceptable. For TM, definition will change to nondisabling.</p> <p>Arrive by 3.5 hr will be changed to 4.5hr. Easy button EMS feedback tool will be available in GWTG. Currently formatting to a different software to ensure tracking. MCHD will share with the region. Will roll out to all EMS participants for an 80% compliance rate with CEUs. RACE and LANS quiz included. This could possibly roll out nationwide. Flyers provided. SETRAC to send to stroke coordinators.</p> <p>Continued education discussed. Dr.'s Andrei and Anne Alexandroff will present at SETRAC on Taking your Stroke Program to the Next Level.</p> <p>D2N 30 minutes within 50%: Requested those with best practices share with the committee. HCA SouthEast is at 43%. MH Mem City are performing well.
