

**Pediatrics Committee** – The chair is Dr. Brent Kaziny. The committee met virtually on 08.13.2020. Dr. Kristin Ernest with Texas Children’s Hospital presented to the committee on Pediatric Concussions and Sports Medicine. Nursing and EMS CEUs were provided.

The 2020 goals were reviewed and reconfirmed. The committee operates with three subgroups that focus on child abuse screening tools, publishing one regional pediatric practice guideline annually, and committee education for continuing education credit.

The Regionwide Child Physical Abuse Screening Tool has been developed at GETAC and is currently in review. This workgroup is working to include pre-hospital usage. The focus of the annual publication of a pediatric guideline will focus on pediatric imaging and dosage recommendations. Literature is currently in review. Kimberly Williams, Program Director of the Anti-Human Trafficking Initiative at Baylor St. Luke’s Medical Center & Coordinator at Houston Area Human Trafficking Healthcare Consortium will present to the committee on human trafficking in October 2020. Nursing and EMS CEUs will be provided. This workgroup continues to seek pediatric and EMS focused education for the committee to aide in increasing participation.

The virtual Pediatric Emergency Care Coordinator (PECC) Symposium is in development and planned to occur in the Spring of 2021. Dr. Kaziny is working to finalize the agenda and secure up to 8 presenters of his choosing. The symposium will consist of a large general overview of PECC leaders, one breakout session for EMS specific education, and one breakout session for hospital specific education.

Several updates to the SETRAC Pediatrics webpage have been made to include relevant and current links to education and resources. The resources were reviewed and approved by the committee prior to addition to the webpage.
