Numbers have begun to decrease but the virus is still fierce. Reinforcing the importance of calling emergency services and the precautions being taken in hospital emergency rooms. Unique messaging ideas are welcome. Thinking about what will happen when schools re-open. Monitoring pedi bed availability. Additional data is now required by the State. <p><b>Presenter: Grace Farquhar/Tracy Akin</b>  <b>Topic: Assessing 2020 STEMI Volume Fluctuations</b></p>	<p>All COVID patients go straight to cath lab at HCA but it is up to individual facilities. EMS call volume is the same, but refusals have increased when arriving at patient location. Patient then codes, increasing resuscitation rates. Increase in “dead on scene” measure. Increased fear of COVID and fear of being alone in hospital. Increase in cancellation of procedures once EMS arrives to facility. Some cardiologists are cancelling procedures without giving lytics. Reasons for cancellation may be added to the data set. Specific reasons needed. SETRAC and Data Subcommittee to decide on questions.
