Presenter: Hilal Salami Topic: Advance Directive for Nursing Home Patients	<p>For EMS: He spoke to the Regional Manager for EMS over 13 counties that licenses. There is currently no law for EMS personnel to ask for Advance Directive but it is best practice. EMS will notate that DNR/Advance Directive was asked for but not produced. Regional message can be sent to all EMS providers stating a report is needed by ED personnel.</p> <p>For Skilled Nursing: The administrators do not deal with patient care and are usually unaware of issues related to DNR/Advance Directives. Licensing has 3 departments that are responsible for the skilled nursing population, one of them being the Social Work department. Nursing home Social Workers have up to 48hrs to ensure all DNR/Advance Directive documents are ready when admitting and if the patient does not have one and wants to get one, they have 48 hours to setup a physician appointment for that purpose.</p> <p>Best solution is communication.
