Area for Improvement

- 1. Communication: Increase our response/reply capabilities, due to the large number of facilities and agencies using the text option, keeping up and replying in a timely manner was trying at times.
- 2. Satellite Phone Education: Develop educational opportunities for the proper use, storage, and maintenance of the satellite phone.
- 3. Information Sharing: Ensure reminders are provided to the coalition on the importance of checking and maintaining the battery life on their battery-operated communication devices.
- 4. Education: Provide educational opportunities and information to the Special Populations group including the difference, purpose, and capabilities of the Satellite Phone and the SETRAC WAVE app.
