<b>Open Discussion</b>	<p>Darrell provided an update on the COVID crisis. 12 facilities reported 271 patients holding for beds; 60 ICU beds, 211 general beds. Staffing is an issue. The State has provided 150 nurses to the Houston area as of now. Patient volumes continue to grow. Potential to open NRG for beds. Oxygen concentrators have been a barrier for discharge in some areas.</p> <p>ACS has formally changed the TQIP Scientific Convention planned for Dec 2020 in Phoenix to a virtual only offering.</p>	The committee has no further recommendations
