Regarding burns; inquired if ambulances are taking burn patients to non-burn centers. Inquired about arrival mode for the patients that presented to level I facilities. Receiving facility must track EMS arrival mode with burn patients due to PHI.	SETRAC will resend tourniquet data spreadsheet. 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	ED LOS data shows from discharge order, not transfer time. TQIP tracks discharge order. If committee wants this information, a spreadsheet and report can be developed. Inquired about breaking down ED LOS data by pedi, adult, and geriatric patients. Adult and Pedi trauma data reviewed. SETRAC will confirm IAP is recognized as the level they are in pursuit of. Noted if non-designated facilities aren't using trauma base, may cause "missing". Would like to know if cut_pierce includes stabbings and non-accidental cuts. Inquired where mechanism name derives from ICD 10 codes; which would help explain all elements of struck by against. SETRAC to check with CDM to determine what is in the reported field that states "missing". Injury e-code is needed to enter data into the registry.
