Topic: Call to Order and Approval of Minutes	Meeting called to order. Minutes approved with no changes.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Amy Iademarco Topic: Quarter 1 2019 Data	Reported stroke volume has increased. One stroke center has not reported yet. Noted one less hospital due to CyFair closing. Allison will begin providing the 45 and 60 minute times at the meetings. Times have already been rolled out with GWTG as a part of target stroke initiative. Subcommittee would like to see RI/TM by eligible patients; not total ischemic strokes. Noted RI/TM should not be a separate category until "back to baseline" has been removed. Coding instructions and guidelines will be updated to show the new non-disabling category. Rapid improvement will go to unacceptable category in the Fall 2019. Inquired if return to baseline patients are also put in the RI/TM category. Subcommittee noted patients should only be entered in one category. Recommended adding a "Back to Baseline" category. For SETRAC database, possibly lock options to only pick one reason. Update of database is in progress. tPA administration rates by hospital remain at 14%. 50% of eligible patients received tPA within the window. Window will be changed from 3.5 to 4.5 hrs. Goal is 75%. 4.5hr data will be shown beginning July 2019. Subcommittee agreed to reduce RI/TM by 25% noting goal is 34% in 2019 as the baseline for 2018 is 46%.	Allison to provide 30, 45, and 60-minute tPA administration data at next meeting
Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: LVO Data Report	Jodie, Houston Methodist, noted the SETRAC jot form would be double work as the information is being entered into Quintiles. Recommended using Quintiles for the jot form. Allison noted creating a guide that is still in progress with an instruction guide for data download. Equivalency guide will be sent to coordinators to run the report and send to SETRAC. Allison noted it will not be exact as some questions require 2 answers. Ex: CT date and time. Need to review csv file for headers to import data to jot form. Noted the jot form is a mandate from the JCC leaders. Noted all fields in jot form are not available in	The committee has no further recommendations
