Reviewing falls related to elderly patients that take oral anticoagulants. Looking at data from individual registries and bringing to cardiac committee as many are on Pradaxa or Eliquis. Generate form letter to Cardiologist for patients to see cardiologist in 2 weeks due to a fall. Discussed patients coming in from nursing homes without documented advance directive. It is a regional requirement and a \$500 fine for the nursing home as it is a DSHS policy.	Possibly generate letter for fall patients to see Cardiologist in 2 weeks

Topic: Stop the Bleed	nurses. Trauma plan must be developed, and kits required. TEA will approve the course that will be provided by October 1st. Kat has sent requests for trainer assistance. Schools must implement by January 1, 2020. Cannot be a computer-based training; must be hands-on. Kati noted needing trainers on August 13th for a 10am and 4pm at Green Tweed and Company. Link is on list that was sent by Kat. HCEC noted 90 nurses are being taught on August 19th from 10a-1:30p. Request for trainers on August 15th at Red Bluff Elementary	assistance
Presenter: Kati Bare Topic: Firearm Safety	Reviewed data from June meeting. Reaching out to Medical Examiner's office for additional data. Will now look at the top 5 zip codes for each intention. Will review at next meeting or establish a GoToMeeting. Cost of Healing Hurt Program discussed. Kati discussed with physician involved in this program. \$350k for 90 clients per year. Program is evidence informed but not evidence based. This will be a hospital program versus community program. Encouraged members to take note and report patients who arrive to hospital without an Advance Directive in place. Once data is received, will see which hospitals will benefit from program and move forward. Recommended providing CEOs with data showing cost of unfunded victims.
