Blinded RI/TM report shown Remaining strokes within the window should be documented. Will remove total within the window and have RI/TM and Other with percentage. Specify lower is better. Goal is to have data collected by hospitals auto-fill the Jot Form. Currently the data will be used to identify if the pre-hospital stroke guideline protocol is being used effectively. Adding additional fields. Currently working to identify patients that received tPA within 30, 45, and 60. Allison provided Q2 2019: 4.5 hours D2 Revascularization in 90: 42.4% with 25/59 patients. Goal is 50% D2N in 30: 15.7% with 29/185 patients. Goal is 50%. D2N in 45: 63.2% with 103/163 patients. Goal is 75% D2N in 60: 95.2% with 109/167 patients Denominators are different due to reasons for exclusion. 6 hour AHA data class will be held at AHA office. Flyers provided.
