Presenter: Dr. McCarthy/Todd Caliva Topic: Call to Order/Approval of Minutes	Todd Caliva welcomed the group and introductions were made. The meeting minutes were approved as written.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Q1 2019 Data Review	RDC Requested Aggregate Data collection points reviewed. Data Registry feedback points also reviewed. Darrell Pile supports submission of aggregate data noting the hospital names can be removed from the dataset. Noted concerns about additional costs statewide. The need for PHI is unclear unless data is married to EMS records. Inquired why data would be provided prior to guidelines for data usage. Clarity is needed regarding data protection and who would have access to the data later. A clear definition of how data would be governed is needed. RDC must indemnify for facility HIPAA breach. Insurance against breach liability. Committee requested concerns are addressed prior to making decision. Q1 2019 data reviewed. Made it more in line with changes made to NCDR. Email was sent to those with access to the database regarding the changes. Some hospitals entered data prior to the upgrade and have not re-entered with the new datapoints. Current data shows roughly half of the hospitals have entered the new datapoints. Deadline is October 30th. D2B Report reviewed. Noted a large increase in red category due to hospitals that have not reentered their data or have not reported at all. Grace to re-send the reminder email for hospitals to re-enter their data. New data elements reviewed. Noted NCDR changed the reasons for exclusion for not meeting the D2B times for transfers and direct admits. Attempted to clarify the lytics component for transfer patients by drilling down. Patients expired in ED or prior to cath lab has been given its own category at 20%. Chest Pain Coordinators to receive data prior to CEO to be reviewed. CEO report will have regional and hospital specific data. Dr. McCarthy noted being willing to collaborate with outlier hospitals regarding lytics. Suggested the	Committee requested RDC concerns are addressed prior to making decision.



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	two highest volume facilities perform pilots to collaborate with non-PCI capable facilities. Amy noted requesting information from each facility regarding the non-PCI capable facilities that they collaborate with.	
Presenter: Liza Ruff/Tracy Akin Topic: Data/QI Update - STEMI Transfers - Case Study: Subsequent ECG	Clarification from NCDR regarding patients coming from a Free-Standing ED reviewed. Noted any Free-Standing ED with an AHA number (including your own) will be coded as a transfer per the rule. If the facility does not have an AHA number, it is not a transfer. Effective Jan 2019, AHA number is needed to be considered a transfer with 120-minute goal. Noted 1st medical contact starts when EMS touches the patient at the non-AHA transfer facility. Case Study: Example: Patient has a subsequent ECG that shows STEMI <i>after</i> they left the first (transferring) hospital. If the patient's STEMI diagnosis is a subsequent ECG that occurs <i>after</i> departing from outside hospital, the patient is not a transfer for STEMI or PCI. They should be reported in <i>2a-Number arriving via EMS/ambulance AND not a transfer</i>. They should <u>not</u> be reported in 2d. If they are not reported in 2d, they <u>are not reported</u> in numbers 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, or 8 (lytic and transfer measures). The subsequent ECG time should be used to report in 10, 11 and/or 12 (door to balloon measures).	The committee has no further recommendations
