A clinical advisory council of pedi and neonatal subject matter experts along with EMS was formed to begin writing a draft PEMS plan. They meet again to finalize the plan in January. Plan will become an annex to the CMOC plan. Tabletop exercise of the plan will be Feb 6th. Evacuation drill is a part of grant and requires evacuation of 20% of licensed beds in 25 counties in 90 minutes. Mental health and Neonatal patients can't be moved. Requested recommendations for presenters and topics. Dr. Kaziny has created a draft outline created. Dr. Kaziny to reach out to possible presenters. Can extend invite to presenters outside of RAC Q. Would host at SETRAC Conference Center so should minimize costs. Will host at SETRAC.
