Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: Q2 2019 Adult & Peds Data	Requested committee leadership bring in bullet points to subcommittee after reviewing data during pre-meeting. Data is not sent quarter by quarter. CDM combines the quarters. Adult: Recommended contacting CDM to drill down on why “missing” is allowed as it should be auto rejected when validated. Ask which AIS codes are used for this. (.9). Suggested sharing Firearm data with Firearm Safety WG. Trend missing data points as education may be needed if increases occur. Send trainings out to non-designated facilities as well. Data should only include NTDB data. Per CDM, there is not ISS submission with data, it is calculated from AIS. Andrew will attempt benchmarking RAC data to Texas or national data. Andrew or Stephen to reach out to non-designated facilities to ensure they have the proper education. Shriner’s TMC is a rehab that is closing and merging with Shriner’s Galveston Burn Center. “Other” is sometimes used if incident occurs to patient that is already in the hospital.
