ISS mortality below benchmark. Compare 2018-2019 ISS with mortality rate. Requested members think about how COVID affected transfer out by level Jessica Yell to discuss top 10 mechanisms at the Injury Prevention meeting. Increase in "missing" category in 2019. Education needed. Noted 2019 top comorbid numbers are inaccurate. Adult data reviewed. 25,148 adult records included in data set. Firearm data will be shared with firearm safety workgroup meeting. Will check with CDM regarding how "NA" occurs. Comparative annual slides reviewed. Will develop 1-2 macro slides to present at the Trauma Committee meeting.
