Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: COVID-19 Impact on Stroke Volumes	Data reviewed. 20 hospitals are now reporting data through June 2020. Decrease of 23.5% in April for patients arriving by personal transport. Increase in resuscitation on scene in April and May. EMS runs are returning to normal volume but resuscitation on scene continues to rise. Death on scene continues to rise.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Donald Garrett Topic: Q2 2020 Data Review	Data reviewed. Noted we are still at 14% for tPA administration. Too Mild (non-disabling) is the highest reason for not providing tPA with Return to Baseline following. Rapidly Improving previously followed Too Mild. Possible education for "other" reasons. Some reasons should be sent back to abstractor to re-categorize. Additional data points were reviewed. Noted increase in patient transfers after tPA. This could be due to ICU capacity.	The committee has no further recommendations
Open Discussion	Updates to the database discussed. November 30 th is the next submission date. 2019 – Q2 2020 data for CEO reports will be send out for 7 day review. SETRAC "For Life's Sake" Public Messaging Campaign is being developed to encourage the general public to call 911. Campaign was developed based on data and stakeholder feedback.
