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| <b>Presenter: Dr. David Weisoly</b><br><b>Topic: Perinatal QI Workgroup</b> | <p><b>Data Review:</b> Reviewed January 2019-June 2020 data. Received 100% of data submission since 2019. Q3 2020 data past due (November 30, 2020). Requested looking back 3-4 months to ensure the steroid data is accurate.</p> <p><b>Neonatal &amp; Maternal Program Manager Collaborative:</b> Inaugural meeting will be held on 12.17.2020</p> <p><b>Breastmilk at Discharge:</b> Will provide slide deck to stakeholders upon approval. CDC data shows Texas as #15 in "ever breastfed". 2019-2020 Houston statistics show all NICU admission increased from 62% in 2019 to 69% in 2020. VLBW infants increased from 27% in 2019 to 31% in 2020 with goal of 60% or more. SETRAC goal is all NICU at 80% and VLBW at 40%. Tiered goals reviewed. Recommended facilities build a team to achieve goal. The committee approved and seconded the Breastmilk at Discharge project to move forward and implement in the SETRAC region. Toolkit will be posted on the SETRAC website.</p> <p><b>Antibiotic Timeliness:</b> Identified multifactorial issues. Timely placement. Follow up with pharmacy. Communication between disciplines. Goal is to improve care of the babies and ensure timely administration of the antibiotics for the babies; not just improving the numbers. Time of birth to administration time should be used to calculate the gap between the order time versus delaying the order.
