Allen Sims is spearheading the revisions of the transport guidelines. Standardizing pedi and adult guidelines. Working on pedi, adult, and geriatric guidelines. Criteria for trauma transport and which trauma centers will be sent to trauma surgeons for input. Recommended adding guideline to point out differences in scoring peds vs adults. Secondary consideration will be on the algorithm. Will send out to members to obtain feedback. Noted revisions will not be finalized by January Board meeting.
