Presenter: Tracy Akin/Grace Farquhar Topic: Data/QI Update - Q1 2019-Q3 2020 Data Review - COVID-19 Comparative Data	Data reviewed. Requested abstractors review their DIDO data to meet the 2021 goal. Noted increase in EMS delays due to COVID and inquired about STEMI diversion. HCA has a "no diversion" policy for stroke, STEMI, and trauma. Goal is no STEMI diversion due to capacity issues regionwide. While reviewing the comparative data, noted many of the "dead on scene" cases occur due to family delay in calling EMS. In some cases, the patients may have passed away in their sleep, for instance, and family did not check on them due to COVID. Failures of resuscitation are higher possibly due to sicker patients than 2019.	The committee has no further recommendations
