Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: Q3 2020 Data Review	Adult Data: Noted increase in penetrating trauma and homicide. Level by ISS: Will re-run data Q1-Q3 2020 data to identify outliers. HCA will also re-run internal data. Ask CDM which validator is being used. ITDX or NTDS validator? ITDX has ISS, but NTDS does not. May cause "missing" error. Top 5 Mechanisms: All 2019-2020 top 5 mechanisms will be reviewed at the next meeting. Requested adding the ISS to the "Transfer In vs Outcome" slide. Committee will report to EMS Committee to close the gap. Peds Data: Data reviewed. Will review top mechanisms for mortality – adult and pedi. Requesting data from CDM.	Ask CDM which validator is being used.
