This project is a QI initiative to increase the proportion of newborn infants with admission temps within normal limits through the implementation of best practices. Data collection begins April 2021. Enrollment status review. RAC Q is behind other larger RACs at 28% enrolled.	SETRAC willing to assist where needed.

Proposed that the committee approve and authorize the maternal morbidity and mortality workgroup to finalize the triggers and post on the perinatal webpage. Committee approved. Slide designed as poster for your reference and has been added to the perinatal webpage. Quality awards will be presented for goal achievement. Location of toolkit reviewed with committee. Antibiotic Timeliness: Aggregate 2020 data received. 38%-40% of infants receiving ABX past 1 hour from order. Finalizing the project goals with tiered improvement measures. Will upload resources to perinatal webpage. Clarification of the measure noted. Time starts at birth to administration, not order to administration. Updated in data dictionary and FAQ document. Maternal Quality Measures: No update at this time. Working to get measure in a reportable format to possibly begin reporting in July 2021.
