Presenter: Dr. Emily Kidd Topic: Trauma Pediatric Transport Guideline Revisions	Guidelines reviewed with committee. Revisions also shared with the trauma and EMC committees. Barriers to completion involve the 45-minute guide that says if you're severely injured and less than 45 minutes away, you should go to a pediatric level one trauma center. Wording has been changed. 45-minute cut off removed to include more generic wording. Confusion around the level I/II pedi centers. Unclear language around air vs ground. If child is not stable enough to make it, should go to closest facility for stabilizing treatment. If child is stable enough, they should go to pediatric trauma center. Pedi trauma center is preferable if child is stable to make it. Recommended feedback from trauma surgeons and ER physicians. Once most up to date version is gathered, it will be sent out.
