Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: Q1-4 2020 Data Review	Data slides reviewed and are being presented for all four quarters of 2020. Requesting data to be sent in as quickly as possible in the future. Data is sent to CDM, where they generate the reports to be presented and it is most beneficial if all the data is included. 2021 Data Dictionary will not include isolated burn data and will not be reviewed moving forward. The committee will continue to collect the data so it is readily available if needed in the future. Adult Data: Noted increase in adult data is still occurring monthly and annually. Level 1 and Level 2 facilities make up most of the hospital arrivals. Level by ISS: Missing ISS are largely in Level IV. Please review data to make sure you are not missing ISS information in data that has been submitted. Currently at 3% missing across all levels but would like to be at 1%. Mortality is not increasing amongst the cases. Mortality data should not be missing ISS information, unless autopsy has not been completed. Top 5 Mechanisms: Fall, MVO, Firearm, Struck by Against, Cuts/Pierce/Stabbings. Watching to see if fall numbers will increase for 2021 Q1 due to the ice storm. Noted that 20% of the top 5 are violence related. Would like to add mortality rate by columns for each of the top 5. "Transfer In vs outcome" slide has now been included and research group will dig in further as more data becomes available. Pedi Data: Will be presented once all Q4 data is collected and reviewed.	Submit Pedi data as soon as possible. Would like to see trauma levels in the year-to-year graphs. Andrew will work with Level IV facilities to go through cases and review missing ISS information. Please review for missing or .9 codes
