Presenter: Peri Smith Topic: Best Practice Education	Peri Smith with Memorial Hermann The Medical Center presented best practice education: The Role of a Stroke Coordinator in Improving Post-Operative Nursing Care for Patients Undergoing Carotid Revascularization Procedures. A medical power plan was developed to standardize and track post-operative care for neurosurgical and cardiovascular carotid revascularization patients. A Quality Improvement project was created to track the noncompliance cases and use those to create best practices guidelines.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Donald Garrett / Susan Zamora Topic: CSC LVO Data Collection Update	LVO Data collected covers January – December 2020 and was collected from 9 CSC facilities and 1 PSC facility. Stroke severity scale/score and transfer metrics were incomplete, missing, or inaccurate on many records received from several facilities and therefore data is subject to change. The records will be sent back to the facilities to review and revise their entries. Need to emphasize to the EMS agencies that run sheets must reflect stroke severity scale. Suggestion to host a class for stroke data abstractors on where to locate and how to accurately classify the data. LVO missing data topic will also be presented at the EMS committee meeting. Data reviewed for discharge disposition of Ischemic Stroke Patients - transfer vs direct presentation patients.	Get with EMS agencies to make sure run sheet is properly documented
Open Discussion	Request has been submitted for funding from SETRAC to allocate for training of EMS agencies on using a stroke severity scale. Introduced the new SETRAC publication, The Fusion.	The committee has no further recommendations
