Participation requirements depend on timely submission of data, if your facility is not submitting your data please let Grace Farquhar know if you need assistance in getting this submitted due to short staffing or other issues. STEMI numbers showed an increase during this quarter. Will continue to monitor these numbers. EMS transport numbers are decreasing, this statistic could change once all data is submitted. D2B times are well within 90 minutes are well above the regional goal of 90%. DIDO times of less than 30 minutes continue to be below the regional goal of 75% and continues to slowly trend downward. For transfer patients, lytics administration is above the regional goal of 75%. New data fields have been added to the database and collection of this data began in April of 2021.
