Presenter: Sam Vance Topic: 2022 EMS for Children Survey	Dr. Kathryn Kathari is the new program director for the ESMC State Partnership for the State of Texas. Training for pediatric specific equipment is subpar and needs to be implemented throughout the state. Rules and guidelines for this training is being reviewed by the education committee. EMS for Children Survey is now a yearly survey and EMS agencies will be reviewed to ensure they are providing skills training for pediatric specific guidelines and equipment. Survey will run from January through March of 2022. Please participate in this survey. Two hospitals have completed the NPRP and six facilities are working towards recognition in this program. The EMS Recognition Program has 12 agencies with current recognition. The current program will be suspended until revisions have been made. The PECC Workforce Development Collaborative has over 1500 participants internationally. 36 participants are from Texas, including 17 EMS agencies, 19 hospitals. It is currently in Phase 1 and Phase 2 will begin in March of 2022. Forty percent of hospitals participated in the 2021 NPRP Assessment. Pediatrics is no longer considered a special population in the New National EMS Education Standard and is now part of the entire curriculum.	The committee has no further recommendations
