Presenter: Stephen Mora Topic: "It's Only A White Line" Program – Data Points	Stephen Mora presented data points/statistics on the stranded motorist deaths in Harris County. Ben Taub and Memorial Hermann – TMC participated in the study. Statistics show that most victims were outside of their stranded vehicle when being injured. Houston Transtar and Stacy Drake collaborated to put together the "It's Only A White Line" campaign. Stranded Motorist could now be a cause of injury listed within the facilities for data collection. Stephen will reach out to Tonya to see which other facilities would like to participate and provide this data and if the idea supported throughout the region with the trauma facilities, as well as the Trauma Committee. Possible that the Trauma Research group could spearhead this project. Injury Prevention would possibly like to receive this data as well.
