August 2021 showed decline in stroke patients than July 2021, could be due to primary and secondary diagnosis changing with current COVID surge. Patients receiving Alteplase/TNK within 30 minutes in the region is currently sitting around 21%, and the goal is to be at 50%. Regional administration rates have been around 13% for the past three quarters and have risen to 14%, will watch to see if the rate continues to rise. Data dictionary has been revised and is available on the SETRAC website and in the SETRAC Stroke Database. Please consult the data dictionary before entering data. Inpatient strokes should not be counted, only patients arriving with stroke signs/symptoms. Q4 2021 data is due February 28, 2022. Data Subcommittee Co-Leader is needed. There has been one nominee to date, please submit any recommendations to Susan Zamora or Tonya Carter. Leader for position will be chosen the following week.
