Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Q3 2021 Data	August 2021 saw a decrease in stroke patients and could be associated with COVID patients arriving in hospitals skewing numbers as primary and secondary diagnosis could change when patients are arriving. Regional goal of patients receiving Alteplase and TNK is 50 percent and current regional average is 21 percent. Other than the “rapid improvement” category, not much change in the acceptable, system, and areas of opportunity reasons for not administering TNK or Alteplase. For regional reporting purposes, inpatient strokes should not be considered in the stroke data collected.	The committee has no further recommendations
