Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Data/QI Update Q3 2021 Regional Data Review	Data received from 31 of 35 PCI facilities. Once data is submitted from missing facilities, data is likely to change. Total STEMI's for Q3 2021 are more than Q2 2021, possibly due to COVID surge. The past two quarters have shown an increase in patients arriving via "transfer". Patients receiving PCI continue to receive D2B within ninety minutes, which is above the regional goal of 90%. Transfer patients that have DIDO times greater than thirty minutes continues to fall below the regional goal of 75% and is slowly trending downward. Database is currently being upgraded; "optional fields" will now become required.	The committee has no further recommendations
Presenter: Olga Ortega / Tracy Akin / Shawna Robinson, Patrick Byrnes Topic: STEMI Coordinator Subcommittee Update - Non-PCI Toolkit: Medication List - Percentage of STEMI activation cancellations - EKG Transmissions	Olga Ortega, STEMI Coordinator for Baylor St. Luke's Hospital presented her STEMI Treatment Guide. SETRAC cannot promote medications, so documents cannot name any specific named drugs. Percentage of activation cancellations patient numbers are being reviewed. Some patients coming back from Cath Lab have minimal disease or clean coronaries. COVID positive patients could be skewing these numbers.
