PECC (Pediatrics Emergency Care Coordinator) workshop was done some time ago was well received. Videos were compiled both tracks for the prehospital and in-hospital track of the PECC workshop and have obtained IRB approval through Baylor College of Medicine to do a study looking at its effectiveness and improving the PECCS in communities. Shooting for late summer as the starting point of dissemination getting the videos across the state. In hopes to get viewing and sharing experience as PECCS or challenges or becoming a PECC. Presenter: Cary Cain, Ph.D./Angie Hayes, MS Topic: New Business • Child Abuse Prevention /Screening Toolkit	April is Child Abuse Awareness Prevention Month. Cary Cain presented on mechanism by which adverse childhood experiences influence health and well-being throughout the lifespan. Traumatic experience can change the genetic code for future generations and effect the nerve development. CDC Preventing Adverse Childhood Experiences (ACEs) Intervene to lessen immediate and long-term harms. GETAC Pediatric Council: released their Child physical abuse screening/management toolkit. It can be found under committee resources. https://dshs.texas.gov/emstraumasystems/pediatricscouncil.shtm . It includes Red Flags for child abuse and other pertinent information. ACS Trauma Quality Programs recognizing child abuse, elder abuse, and intimate partner violence. https://www.facs.org/quality-programs/trauma/tqp/center-programs/tqup/best-practice Angie spoke on the abuse screening toolkit she is working on. Gave a quick background on the process. Advised that GETAC's outline is good information. Got buy in from leadership/key stake holders, and leaders such as physicians, nurse, ED, Education and Social Work. Spoke with Risk Management and Executives for approval. 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	Texas Children. Screening will go live April 1st. will monitor the use of the tool to ensure it is used widely and correctly. Went over the workflow chart and the screening tool for Texas Children. Gave a Prevention overview of the different community programs they have partnered with 1) Upstart Family communities program through Baylor College of Medicine Public Health Pediatrics, 2) Duke University Family connects international family a brief home visitation nursing program that supports postpartum parents in caring for their newborn, 3) Up Lift home visitation program supporting pregnant or postpartum women up to one year. 4) Up Words group based early language development program for families with children 0-24 months. The mission is to prevent and mitigate childhood adversities, foster resilience in children, families, and the community; and provide care for the most vulnerable children in Texas. Have clinical services teams with the child abuse teams using assessment strategy, innovation, provide education training and outreach, research, and evaluation. Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: New Business Pediatric Data Review	Andrew presented the SETRAC Trauma Data Q3 2021 for Pediatrics showing trauma level by month and how data is collected and reviewed. He gave a brief overview of the data points that are used and could be used for the Pediatrics. Andrew gave a brief overview on trauma levels and destination by month, level by ISS and missing ISS, the top five mechanisms, hospital arrival method, injury severity score with mortality by percentage. Presenter: Dr. Brent Kaziny Topic: Standing Report NPRP Assessment Results	Dr. Kaziny presented the Texas State EMS for children state partnership data 2021 review from the National Pediatrics Readiness Summary. Data collected in the state of Texas had a response rate of over 50% the national rate was over 70%. Texas represents over 10% of the Total EDs surveyed across the country. Overall, the state summary 265 hospital that participated there were 151 that have low pediatric patient volume. Briefly went over Trauma Facility vs Non-Trauma Facility. Showed the highs and lows in areas of concern for physician and nurses. The single most likely thing to improve is the waited pediatric readiness	The committee has no further recommendations
