A. Call to Order

Mike Nixon called the meeting to order at 1:00 pm.

B. Minutes (C101)

Mr. Nixon requested review of the July minutes. Suzanne Curran (CHI St. Luke's Sugar Land) made a motion to approve the minutes, Christy Gonzales (Wharton EMS) seconded the motion, and the corridor members carried the motion. The minutes were approved as written.

C. New Business

- **“Tactical Decision Game: Flood Scenario” Tabletop**

Gabe Lavine led the corridor members in a tabletop exercise working through a flood scenario.

D. HPP Capabilities Review

- **EMResource Juvare Q&A**

Jeremy Way reported the Juvare EMResource update includes an Active Attack which does not necessarily need to be an active attack. It can be a security situation; for example, Baytown had a gang shooting with about 14 GSWs showing up at the facility within three minutes and within another two minutes approximately 200 people rushed their Emergency Room, and they had a difficult time locking down. Mr. Way walk the corridor members through the drop-down selections to set this level.
