	LVO data: prehospital information, reporting hospital information, and transfer hospital information. LVO data are more in-depth looking at transport data and how well the EMS prehospital stroke guidelines are being used and how sufficient if used. With the new RAC rules the questions to ask is are all the hospital in the region using the stroke registry? What general stroke data is applicable to all hospitals, what is not being shared that need to be included at committee meetings such as mortality rate, discharge disposition, first medical contact time, and suspected strokes not transferred to hospital by EMS, patient refusal, DOA, etc. What data reports would be beneficial whether a current report or new that need to be developed that would help in looking at our regional system of care for stroke and what improvements need to be made. It would not only go out to the stroke committee but EMS agencies, public health, local government leaders, public, and those facilities that have those patients after they leave the hospital, etc. What new data need to be captured to fulfill the requirement. Data reports current/new that would be beneficial for improving the regional stroke system of care. Regional wrist bands for patients. It started off with trauma patients. The state is interested in it being applied to stroke patients. There are issues funding, how EMS would track it in their electronic medical records, facilitates, and will it make it to the registry. There is an EMS agency that is piloting it for all their patients. New data metrics/gaps to be filled to meet the requirements of the new RAC rules FSEDs (not hospital affiliated) agreements with hospital systems for stroke, STEMI, etc.
