A. Call to Order

Dena Daniel opened the meeting at 9:01 am.

B. Approval of Minutes (C101)

• EMResource Notifications

Ms. Daniel gave more clarification to the details surrounding the EMResource MCI notifications. EMS has the ability to send out MCI notifications through EMResource, but most do not use tool. She advised it is best to notify SETRAC of an event so they can assist by sending out an EMResource notification since the hospitals are unable to send them out.

Mr. Ericksen advised the corridor members that the SMA for COVID response ended June 30th, 2022. Federal funding has dropped from 100% to 90/10%; therefore, SETRAC is not receiving any more COVID tests or PPE from the state and does not have the inventory to support requests so STAR requests will need to go through the facilities' local jurisdictions.

H. Inventory Update

COVID DME collection is complete.

- If DSHS reaches out regarding missing equipment, feel free to direct them to me COVID SMA has ended.
- No COVID Tests or PPE will be distributed by SETRAC.
- All requests for PPE/Tests need to be routed via STAR through local jurisdiction.
- Funding for TDEM has dropped so there is a chance that they will have to pick up the requested items from a TDEM warehouse.

Annual HPP Inventory is still being conducted and must be completed as soon as possible
