Presenter: Grace Farguhar Topic: Old Business EMS Data Collection	Grace spoke on EMS data collection. Starting August 2023 all the RACs in Texas are going to start doing self-assessments for different clinical services and prehospital. Its going to start with prehospital and then Trauma, Cardia, Stroke, and other service lines will follow. We are looking at collecting data from EMS it is helpful to know from this committee if there are specific metrics that you are not getting as a hospital that you need from EMS. Some of the things looked at are the total number of runs per month, how many of those are calls about STEMI, how many of those patients were deceased upon arrival, how many needed CPR, and if there is anything that the hospital does not capture that is needed from EMS. Getting this information will help give a better picture of the region, something our EMS partners can start collecting, and start presenting at the committee meetings to determine if there is need for improvements. Grace will present the fields of location of incident, contact time, number of 911 calls for cardiac arrest, time they left the scene and how many agencies are capturing it to the EMS group for feedback. We are partnering with Texas Cares to get information on bystander CPR which is shared at the committee and EMS committee meetings. Hopefully, we will be able to take a better look at the data and get patient level data (not patient information or PHI) to look a little deeper to see if there is a certain area where bystander CPR is administered and the survival rate. Cath lab activation/deactivation tracking was discussed for data collection.	The committee has no further recommendations

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Presenter: Tonya Carter TOPIC Protocols ○ Lytics and FSED	Grace spoke on Tonya's behalf. The FSED group met previously and agreed to submit data to get an idea of what the census look like on patients they are seeing to get a better idea on Lytics usage in the FSED. They are looking to collect cardiac, stroke data, and sepsis. The cardia data was sent out to everyone in June, so far there have been a couple of responses it will be sent back out to the FSED again. Questions to ask was given: What the total number of patients presented to a final diagnosis of STEMI of those patients how many received an EKG upon arrival, how many received aspirin, how many received Lytics within 30 minutes, if Lytics was available and how many, DIDO within 30 minutes, was 911 or ambulance used to transport patients to the hospital for higher level of care.
