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Presenter: Chris Campbell Topic: ACS Survey in the Virtual World	The Texas Level III and Level IV call was a couple of weeks ago it is still with the rules committee and will not go into effect until January 2024. There were a lot of word changes. Performance Improvement wording was changed from within 24 hours to within 72 hours. Typically, some centers do not work weekends, they have holidays off, and vacations so it has been extended to 72 hours. As soon as the new rules come out Chris will review them and provide a template. ACS had their clinical congress meeting the level IV standards are being developed with the workgroup in 2023. A survey was sent out for participation for the rules changes Chris will send the link to Tonya to send out to the group for all the level IV centers. Revisions to the chart code book will be released in the next few months. Minor changes to chapter 2,3,4,5, and a significant change to chapter 8.4 (commitment to post graduate education). Next month they are coming out with a chart code book question and answer. A new PRQ is coming out for 2023.
