Presenter: Dr. Jonathan Aliota, MD, MS, FACC Topic: Cardiac Care Education Series ○ Understand stable vs unstable chest pain ○ Define and better understand the diagnosis of unstable angina	Dr. Aliota, presented and spoke on understanding stable vs. unstable chest pain and defining and better understanding the diagnosis of unstable angina. There are different levels of chest pain (chest pain while eating, changing positions, exertion, lasting more than 20 minutes, associated syncope/pre-syncope). According to the ACC/AHA guidelines for the management of patients with unstable angina it depends solely on the patient's clinical history, clinician's interpretation, and judgement. All chest pain isn't the same people have a dynamic presentation you will not catch everyone. The chest pain that kills is the chest pain due to lack of blood flow to the heart as the heart muscle becomes inflamed. Subjective evidence was shown relating to lack of blood flow to the heart. History is 95% of diagnosis. The tests we have are there as a junction to help confirm what is true based on the pretest probability.
