Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: Call to Order/Approval of Minutes	Andrew Hiriart called the meeting to order. The minutes from the meeting on November 10, 2022, were approved. Presenter: Andrew Hiriart Topic: New Business Q1-Q2 2022 Data Review	John Coley reported on Q1-Q2 2022 Pediatric data. The report included data for 2,418 pediatric records from 33 facilities. Patients include in the report are from ages 15 and younger. Total Volumes by Quarters – Total trauma patients for Level I and Level IV facilities continues to trend upwards. Level by ISS – Showing improvement with only 4 missing ISS scores. ISS with mortality Rate – Low ISS mortalities at Level I and Level IV. Level I facilities show 18 mortalities. All other facilities had one or no mortalities to report. Mortality by Age – This report will be reviewed to meet the criteria of the new RAC self-assessment that will be implemented in 2023. Age groups will be revised to reflect the self-assessment criteria. Top 5 Mechanisms of Injury – Sharp uptick in firearm data. Potential drill down. The “struck by against” and “motor vehicle occupant” categories have traded places over the years. Falls continues to be the leading cause of trauma. Future reports will include an age breakdown for the top 5 mechanisms of injury. Hospital Arrival Method – ISS will be added to future reports. Transfer In vs Outcome – Level I facilities reported a mortality rate of <0.5% for Q1-Q2 2022. No mortalities were reported in the other designated trauma levels.
