Presenter: Rachel Leicht Topic: New Business - Stroke Education - Houston Methodist TMC	Rachel Leicht, Stroke Program Manager at Houston Methodist TMC did a presentation on 2022 DNV Finding. Post-alteplase or post neuro endovascular procedure required. Documentation was missing at expected intervals -assessment, -reassessment, - physical notification. Causes: -practice in ICU to verbally communicate with providers, -various flowsheets in EMR. Corrective action plan is to review and revise EMR, optimize workflow. To educate, audit, remind and revisit. -Post-Alteplase: standard guidelines -Post-Angiogram: Q15x4, Q30x4, Q1x4, Q4x4, assess vita; signs, cath site, pulse distal to access site, and neurological assessment. Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Rehab Utilization/ Wake Up Stroke Research Metrics	The Committee reviewed the draft of the dashboards for rehab utilization and wake up strokes. During the Stroke Data Subcommittee meeting, the meeting attendees opted to rename "wake-up strokes" to "stroke patients arriving between 4.5 hours and 24 hours of last known well. The Stroke Data Subcommittee also suggested edits to the dashboards including changing number of patients to percentages and replacing the "ambulatory" categories with mRS scores. Presenter: Dr. Chethan Rao Topic: Old Business - TNK Implementation Volunteers - Tracking TNK Administration	Dr. Rao discussed the plan to look at the wake-up stroke data this year to try and formulate a problem statement action plan. The goal is to be able to share our findings as a submission to ISC by 08/2024. They discussed that multiple health systems were in the process of transitioning to TNK, and we are a resource if any system is having issues.
