Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Old Business - EMS Metrics for Stroke - SETRAC Data Repository-Stroke - GWTG Download Instructions - Excel Template for Non-GWTG Users - Data Dictionary Revisions - Q4 2022 Stroke Data Submission	On EMS Metrics for Stroke, SETRAC previously received feedback on what data the stroke committee would like EMS to provide information on, to see what the overall data looks like for stroke. The EMS committee will be looking closely at the requested data points and to see if the information can be feasibly obtained. Grace was happy to announce that with the latest upgrade, data can now be downloaded from GWTG. All hospitals will be notified as their data is downloaded. Moving forward, Grace gave the option for hospitals to have their data uploaded monthly or quarterly. Grace is currently working on and will be sending out the GWTG download instructions and the excel templates for non GWTG users. Data may be reported monthly but is due no later than quarterly, 60 days after the end of the quarter. There will be some revisions to the data dictionary. That information will be sent through the list serve for review and will be discussed at next meeting. The Q4 2022 Stroke Data Submissions was postponed due to all the changes to the get with the guidelines. Hospitals have the option to manually input their data, or SETRAC can pull it for them. Data should be submitted by 05/15/23, then the information will be included in the next stroke meeting in May. Q1 data is due 05/31/23.	The committee has no further recommendations.

Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Old Business - Q3 Wake-Up Stroke - Rehab Utilization Review	Wake-Up Strokes Patients arriving outside of 4.5 hours LKW was discussed. The main reason they wanted to look at wake-up-stroke is over the years almost 70% of patients that arrive at the ED arrive over 4.5 hours of LKW and it hasn't changed. Grace will be adding another chart to see those coming in from 7am-7pm vs. 7pm to 7am and a chart specifically for demographics. Rehab Utilization Review The rehab utilization dashboards were reviewed. Grace is working on a general data chart from the rehab metrics showing patients that have come into a facility, ED, and discharge disposition. Zip code data will be used for education purposes, and to see if there is a specific area where rehab is being utilized and not. Based on suggestions from the meeting, Grace will be looking to using a heatmap and a separate dashboard specifically based on demographics to show at the next data meeting. She should also have the complete 2022 data.	The committee has no further recommendations.
