There was lots of open discussion and suggestions on dates and times. The zoom option was brought up as well. The group decided on meeting in-person quarterly to align with the cardiac committee meetings. They also decided to meet via zoom in between those in-person meetings. Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: SETRAC Data Updates	Grace advised the EMS committee is currently meeting to look over data metrics they want to review. There is a huge list, so it will be scaled back for now, to focus on a few. A few data metrics they are reviewing are EMS first medical contact, time they leave the scene, how many calls for possible STEMI's, CPR performed, patients that refused transport, etc. Grace mentioned that ECR vendors varies from agency to agency, so they record information differently. The goal is finding a uniform way of collecting data. This involves building a data dictionary for them, so that all agencies are on the same page. The members discussed operation procedures through Pulsara. Grace mentioned SETRAC board has formed a small group that will be looking into and discussing pulsara. The group requested slides from last meeting on Texas Cares data. Grace stated that she would check with Micah for that info. Grace mentioned that on the stroke side, they have access to AHA's GWTG registry for stroke where hospitals download their data. Grace wants to start working on this process for Cardiac data as well, where we can download a file from that registry and then import it into SETRAC. SETRAC would be looking at MCVR chest pain MI registry. We are still waiting on the agreement for that. Grace stated the focus is to update the database later this year. Grace asked if there were any additional data metrics the committee want to look at like; patients at arrivals, how many patients received aspirin at arrival or at discharge, patients injured, uninsured, door to EKG,	The committee has no further recommendations



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	discharge disposition, In-STEMI etc. The members discussed how their facilities were similar and differed in recording data. Grace encouraged the committee to provide insight on what data we should be looking at as a region, that could be discussed at the next meeting.	
Open Discussion	There was more discussion on Lytics data. A suggestion was made to confirm who STEMI coordinators are for all facilities. There were also request for chest pain coordinator positions from a few facilities. Melanie mentioned the Stroke Coordinators Boot Camp and suggested that STEMI coordinators consider doing the same as it has very productive in connecting and networking between facilities. The members discussed the idea of a STEMI bootcamp. New meeting invites will go out with the new meeting schedule.	The committee has no further recommendations
