A small group will meet after that meeting to review the data metrics around the end of July. From that meeting we should get more information on what data points they can provide us from a list they have gotten from all the clinical committees. Grace stated she has put together a document that has download instruction for GWTG. It is currently being tested, for any errors and correction are currently being made. All hospitals will be notified as their data is downloaded. Moving forward, Grace gave the option for hospitals to have their data uploaded monthly or quarterly. Grace reminded all that if they would like her to upload their data, please send her an email requesting that. Grace is currently working on and will be sending out the GWTG download instructions and the excel templates for non GWTG users. There have been some revisions to the current data dictionary. Grace added information to some fields and passed out a draft copy to the members in attendance today for review. She requested the groups input and suggestions to make any revisions and present that information to the Stroke Committee at the July Stroke Committee meeting. Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: Old Business ○ Extended Window Strokes ○ Rehab Utilization Review	Extended Window Strokes Grace previously discussed, Patients arriving outside of 4.5 hours LKW and 24 hours LKW instead of Wake-up stroke. Grace discussed changing and renaming wake up stroke to 24hrs LKW because we want to look at this specific time frames. There was open discussion between the members, whether their facilities follow the protocols from the research of wakeup stroke, or do they do timeframe restricted. The suggestion was to do more research on this topic. The group suggested a survey be sent out to gather more info. Rehab Utilization Review Grace couldn't present any slides due to a technical issue and a system glitch that's not pulling all the data over. However, Grace did discuss she was currently working on Extended Window Strokes. Grace did add length of stay as it was previously requested. She mentioned she did add 3 tabs for EWS. One for demographics, a page for thrombolytics and thrombectomy. This is specific for patients arriving between 4.5 hours and 24 hours LKW. Then are there are the same dashboard for those patients that arrive within 4.5hrs and after 24hrs LKW The goal is to gather and compare these 3 groups. Grace mentioned that she pretty much has all the 2022 data at this point, just a few facilities is missing data from.	The committee has no further recommendations.
