Presenter: Dr. Nichole Davis Topic: 2023 Committee Goals - Collaboration w/ SETRAC Committees - ASPR Grant - Pediatric Disaster Care Center for Excellence Update	Dr. Davis spoke briefly on the ASPR Grant. The grant is a federal funded grant that Dr. Kaziny was awarded. Dr. Davis serves as the Texas Children's site PI. This grant is funded for a year, they are hoping that it continues to be funded. It is the third of its kind the other two sides have been funded year after year they hope to continue in those footsteps. They are a consortium of institutions from across the Gulf it doesn't just include Texas it includes Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, Florida, and Puerto Rico. All hospitals throughout that region encompassing the entire Gulf which is a huge region with a large number of children. A region that sees a lot of natural disasters. They were funded September 30, 2022, it's a yearlong grant and they have a lot of different initiatives. Dr. Davis is the co-lead over the education domain. Coming down the pipe will be a lot of educational initiatives one is a regional functional exercise taking place June 21-22 nd the first day is all tabletop exercises it will not be in Texas but the rest of the region Louisiana, Mississippi, Alabama, Georgia, Florida, and Puerto Rico. Most are radiologic surge exercises there are three other written sites within our region. One will be a mental health trauma and grief tabletop exercise providing resources not only to providers but patients and families real time/just in time. The other two will be Trauma surges of pediatric patients. They are all happening simultaneously they contracted with TEEX to help run them. On the June 22 nd there will be a functional but not full-scale exercise taking place at Texas Children's with the receipt of a large number of radiologic patients to Texas Children's hospital to test their written and reception plan. They are coordinating with an external and internal patient reception site to test their family reception center to do a radiologic triage for a large number of patients. It will also be a full-scale activation of their incident command at Texas Children's as well. They also have a new course that is being piloted in Texas called Pediatric Preparedness for the Healthcare Professional it is a two-day	The committee has no further recommendations.



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	course contracted through TEEEX. They have been hard at work with the content to delivery. This is a course that is intended for any healthcare provider that provides direct patient care that could be involved in a pediatric response. It does have CME, CNE, and also EMS CE's that they are very excited to provide. It is free, Dr. Davis believes it will be 16 hours of continuing education credits. They are piloting it in Texas at Texas Children's hospital the dates are May 24-25 th . A Save the date was sent out. They have seven more deliveries scheduled in July and August throughout the region they will go to every state and back to Texas. The official delivery in Texas will be in Dallas tentative scheduled for September 13-14 th . They will do an evaluation after the first pilot next month and make big overall changes based on the feedback and then finalize the course for the seven different deliveries throughout the region. They are working on a deployable team initiative and increasing clinical resources in the area. The grant isn't to provide direct patient care its to build the infrastructure and to prove that it is possible and build a framework.
