Presenter: Carrie Boyd/Rebecca Nutt Topic: Welcome and Introductions	Rebecca Nutt welcomed everyone. The meeting minutes from the September 6, 2023, were approved with no changes. Presenter: Melanie Aluotto Topic: New Business - Best Practice Calendar 2024 - Board Update 2024 Committee Goals	Rebecca reviewed the best practice calendar with the members. There were slight changes to scheduled facilities as the members discussed what months worked better for their facilities. She gave all members the opportunity to present their best practice. Melanie Aluotto informed the group of previous discussions on this subcommittee meeting being specifically for the coordinators only. There was open discussion in the group. Rebecca stated, as the leader of this committee, she doesn't have a strong opinion on whether the group is open or closed to others. Melanie stated this information has been taken to the board, there will be follow-up on the decision in early 2024. Rebecca reviewed slides on the 2024 STEMI Coordinator Subcommittee Goals. Goal #1 PCI hospitals will give feedback to EMS on patients 80% of the time by end of 2024. Goal #2 PCI facilities will identify at least one free-standing non-PCI facility to partner with by end of March 2024. Goal #3 Education: Implementation of Chest Pain/STEMI Coordinator best practices shared during at least 4 meetings per year. Goal #4 Education: Community outreach – provide education to the public during at least 1 event per year (Ex: social media, print/ad, some type of live event). There was open discussion between the members on these goals. The processes, how its attainable, the relevance, and the time frame to complete. Rebecca also reviews the 2024 Cardiac Committee Goals. Goal #1 Total of transfer patients meeting D2B<120 minutes: Given lytics when deemed appropriate and transferred out within 30 minutes. Goal: 75% by end of 2020. Goal #2 Develop community education, including a regional hands-only CPR event. Goal #3 Unified social media presence related to STEMI regional education. 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Presenter: Olga Ortega- Baylor St. Lukes Medical Center Topic: Best Practice Presentation STEMI Coordinator Role	Olga Ortega from Baylor St. Lukes Medical Center presented her best practice on the role of a STEMI Coordinator. Olga showed slides and discussed her journey from the start of her nursing career 31 years ago. She gave background on her different positions over the years. In October 2019, she started the role as a STEMI Coordinator. She questioned what she was doing, as she was new to the role and didn't really know how to perform her new job duties. She followed a STEMI Coordinator guidebook and took advice from others to "NEVER GIVE UP." Olga showed slides on different resources she used to learn her job duties and excel in performing her task. Olga showed the members the NCDR Chest Pain- MI Registry Achievement awards her facility received over the last 3yrs. They received Silver Performance in 2021 and Platinum Performance Achievement Award in 2022 & 2023. Olga Ortega expressed how much it's a team effort. Olga loves her facility, her coworkers, and her job and will continue to work toward providing exceptional services to those in need. Rebecca thanked Olga for an awesome presentation! Presenter: Grace Farquhar Topic: SETRAC Data Updates	Grace reminded the members that Q3 2023 data is due 11/30/2023. Grace followed up on still working to get an agreement with ACC to get access to NCDR chest pain registry patient level information without the PHI. Once the agreement is established, ACC will send out notifications to all facilities to allow SETRAC access to that information. Grace asked the members to look into "who" is representing their facilities responsible for submitting data. This way ACC will have a direct contact to send and receive that information. At this time, there is no current timetable on when this agreement with ACC will be established, she will continue to give us updates. Grace stated the data subcommittee is currently an Ad Hoc group, but there will be a need to create a subcommittee, as we will start looking at new data sets once this agreement with ACC has been established.
