It is a committee of medical directors that can review any concerns. Melanie presented a link on the SETRAC website, so all members would have access to it. She informed all members if there are cases, trends or any events where there might be concerns, these things can now be referred to the QI program. Dr. Schultz added this would be useful in cases only after taking normal steps of action, with no results. Then reach out to QI program. Dr. Schultz informed the members that there is now an opening for a New Physician Co-Chair for this Cardiac Committee. He presented the QR code and link for the nominations. He invited all to apply for the position. After nominations are received and reviewed there will be a ballot vote. Presenter: Carrie Boyd/Rebecca Nutt Topic: STEMI Coordinator Subcommittee ○ Co-leader Needed	Rebecca Nutt recapped the last subcommittee meeting. They previously brainstormed and discussed ideas about a STEMI bootcamp. She stated it has been decided that each meeting a different facility will share their best practice. Allowing all the members to share ideas and concerns. She also mentioned the committee discussed data updates and looking into the patterns across the region. 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	and participate in events. There will be more to come on this initiative. There was lots of suggestions, ideas, and open discussions between the members. More than a few members showed interest in the Hands-Only CPR initiative.	
Presenter: Olga Ortega Cynthia Hernandez Topic: Standing Reports Q2 2023 Regional Data Review	Olga Ortega presented on the Q2 2023 Regional Data. She reminded all facilities to submit their data. She stated we only have 83% of hospitals that has submitted data. SETRAC has reached out to numerous facilities to get data. She showed a slide on the hospitals data submissions reflecting the decline. She mentioned reaching out to the administration of different facilities to see who is responsible for submitting data. Olga showed slides on Total STEMI's continue to trend down compared to pre-pandemic numbers. She questioned if reason for the decline was maybe due to facilities not submitting data. She showed slides on Direct presentation STEMI patients from Q1 2019 to Q1 2023, still trending down from previous quarters. She showed slides on Direct presentation STEMI patients with Delay in receiving PCI. She showed slides on Transferred STEMI patients with Delay in receiving PCI Q1 2019- Q1 2023. Olga also showed slides on Lystics Administration at referring facilities. Both Freestanding ED's and Non-PCI Hospitals were discussed. She showed there are a large # of people not getting Lystics. The collection of patient level data (no PHI) will assist in determining what factors may be impacting these numbers. Olga showed a slide on Lystics administration rates at referring facilities as it continues to be low. She stated this is an optional reporting at this time. There were questions and open discussion about the data shown. There was a question on the status of the CEO reports. Grace gave an update on the hold up on the CEO reports. She is still waiting back on feedback from the CEO's. Currently there is no ETA. A member asked a question about getting access to the data and trends. Melanie stated that she would work with Grace to see what information can be sent out.	The committee has no further recommendations

Presenter: Dr. Kevin Schulz Topic: 2023 Committee Goals Review/Update ○ Regional Care Plan	Dr. Schulz spoke on the 2023 Committee Goals that were previously set. He discussed the committee participation in helping to achieve these goals. The 1 st focus is data submission requirements and in person attendance participation. He stated this includes the free standing and PCI centers. Dr. Schulz discussed the Regional ACS plan. The plan will be submitted to the SETRAC Board, and it was approved at the July meeting. It is now accessible on the SETRAC website. He reviewed and discussed the SETRAC Cardiac Committee 2023 Goals. Some of which is accomplished while others will be continually work on. He also reviewed and discussed the 2024 Goals. Goal#1 Total of transfer patients meeting D2B<120 minutes: Given lytics when deemed appropriate and transferred out within 30 minutes. Goal: 75% by end of 2020. Goal#2 Develop community education, including a regional hands-only CPR event. Goal#3 Unified social media presence related to STEMI regional education.
